Summary: CICASP Seminar 46

Outreach & Education: Know your audience!

This was the first in a block of three concerning matching your talk content and presentation style to your audience. We developed this theme based upon student suggestions that topics such as speaking to an audience and fine-tuning outreach and education would be beneficial. An article was circulated in advance, about voice pitch and elections. The class was divided into pairs, to work on tasks together for the entire block. To begin with, Fred gave 5-minute demonstrations on how to address each of three different audiences: children (ages 10-15); the general public (adults); and scientists. He spoke about a different topic than the article: a study into hormones, stress and mating in Japanese macaques. He then gave specific tips to help with presenting to each audience. Each pair picked their target audience by selecting at random from a hat and spent the final ten minutes beginning their preparation.

Preparation for Next Week

Each pair of students will meet during the week to share their ideas and thoughts on how to best present the information in the article to their target audience for their presentation. Presentations will be 5-10 min. It is okay to use props and/or PowerPoint slides, if you wish. See the next page for a reminder of which pair is presenting to which audience-type.
