This seminar will help you become familiar with the process and provide useful tips to bring you confidence. We will introduce you to the general structure of professional interviews (on Wednesday, March 11) and provide a number of tips such as effective ways of introducing yourself.

In the following workshop (Wednesday, March 18), you will have an opportunity to practice interviews and make use of what you learned in the previous week.
